## ***Entertaining Angels***

This is the story of an ordinary woman whose early life had its challenges. Her childhood was not particularly happy and later she went from one turbulent relationship to another. Eventually she came to know Jesus as a forgiving Saviour and met a man to whom she became happily married.

In the area where Janet attended church there were a number of homeless men who lived on the streets. Her heart went out to them and from small beginnings, she and her friend Shiela worked together and gradually developed a day care centre where the homeless could have a meal and enjoy the company of others. Next came a night shelter, a charity shop, a team who worked with the police and local council to rescue those in need, a market garden and a furniture recycling scheme.

The organisation became known as "New Hope Trust" and a network of people made themselves available to help in different ways. Many were helped through difficult times, and often came to know Jesus as their Saviour.
